NOTES & NEWS

Signups for Session VI begin Monday, February 10, 2020 at 8:00 am. Classes will run Monday February 24, 2020 through Friday, April 10, 2020. Fees for enrichment classes are \$8 per hour multiplied by the number of meetings in the session. Session IV is 7 weeks long. 1 hour classes=\$56/session. Kinder classes are 2 hrs =\$16 per day and \$112 for 7-week session. All 1.5 hr classes= \$84. March 11, 2020 Minimum Day! Make sure you sign up!

Please remember that all outstanding balances must be paid in full before enrolling your child in the new session!

A \$40 Registration Fee is added to enrollment cost. This fee will be charged once per family per school year, regardless of how many children enrolled in the After School Enrichment Program.

Partial scholarships are available for families who would otherwise not be able to participate in after-school activities. Please speak with the Center's Program Director, Peg Brown Levy, before the start of the new session.
