Registration is on a first come first serve basis. A 50% deposit must be paid at a time of enrollment and the remainder is due before the first day of camp. Cancellations will be refunded, minus a \$20 cancellation fee per camp. There will be no refunds or credits for cancellations made less than 3 weeks prior to the first day of camp.

One week camps are \$200/week Monday – Friday 12-5pm unless otherwise noted. Fees are calculated at \$8/ hour. Camps 3 & 4 are \$160 – No Class on July 4th. All children must have a current ID & Emergency Information form on file to attend camp.
